Anne Ferguson, age 95, of Crown Point, IN, passed away peacefully with her family on Sunday evening, April 26, 2020. She was born September 16, 1924, in Chicago, IL, the proud daughter of Irish immigrants, Frank and Mary Ann (Conaghan) McGuire.
