His two favorite sporting activities in high school, in which he excelled, were wrestling and as a shot putter. His education continued at Indiana University, graduating with a bachelor's degree in journalism and communications. While at I.U., he worked as an editor and reporter on the college's newspaper.

While employed in the steel mills of Northwest Indiana, he also served as a grievance supervisor or shop steward protecting workers' rights and making them aware of their work responsibilities. He was known to be a strong union supporter. With regard to government affairs, he cared for his city of birth dearly, attending and participating in Gary City Council meetings.

Finally, he found the work that he loved the most: broadcasting.

For decades, he was a broadcaster for WLTH radio in Gary. "The Bill K Report". In his later years, his program was aired on Mondays, from 10 a.m. to noon, talking on a wide range of topics, from local government issues to international events and concerns. He would never introduce subject matter without doing extensive and intensive research to verify that the information he was presenting was factually correct and clearly stated. Bill also cared for children, encouraging their educational growth and development in making the future a better place for everyone. He felt that registering to vote and being well informed are the starting points of a strong and vibrant democracy. Bill, know that we love you and miss you.
