Amy Anne Haaland, beloved mother and grandmother passed away Thursday evening on February 15th, 2024. She was born Amy Anne Haaland in Silver City, New Mexico on January 24th, 1959, and was preceded in death by her mother; Amy Ellen Haaland, father; Aage Haaland, and husband; John R. Ramer.
