Andrew Wargo, age 88 of Valparaiso, IN. and Ft. Myers, FL passed away peacefully with his family by his side on January 23, 2026. He was born April 3, 1937, in Gary, IN. Andrew was a graduate of Tolleston High School, Class of 1955. He served in the Army Medical Corps with the 395th Evacuation Hospital during the 1961-62 Berlin Crisis. Andrew retired after 40 years as a glazier for various companies, lastly Southlake Glass. He was a past president and also treasurer of Glaziers Local 1165/82. After retirement he was either golfing or playing Bocce Ball with the neighbors at his Reflection Lakes home in Florida or his favorite hobby making crosses from beveled mirror strips, the last count was over 200. He also would be seen at Sharing Meadows as a member of the Tuesday morning crew during the summer.
