Ann M. Campbell, (nee McKenzie), age 74, of Hobart, IN, passed away November 8, 2016. She was born August 7, 1942 to James and Elizabeth McKenzie (nee MacDonald) of Gary, Indiana. Ann was a resident of Hobart until illness brought her to Crown Point Christian Village.

She was a lifelong educator in Northwest Indiana, primarily at Henry S. Evans, for a majority of her 35 year teaching career, where she educated her beloved third graders. Ann lived in Gary when she entered this world and attended St. Mark's Parish. She graduated from Bishop Noll in 1960, and attended Purdue University in Lafayette, IN., where she received her Bachelor of Arts in Education and later her Master's from Indiana University. She was very active in the Teacher's Union and the Chairperson of the Grievance Committee, where she was very outspoken, fighting for the rights of her fellow teachers. Ann was an animal lover and loved her family, friends, and her students. She inspired a love of learning in her students.

Ann was preceded in death by her dear parents-James and Elizabeth, beloved son-Ryan; loving brother-Donald "Mack" McKenzie and cherished niece-Mary LeJeune. She is survived by her sister-in-law-Virgene McKenzie; niece-Patricia (Rob) Hopps; nephew-James McKenzie; great nieces-Elizabeth, Chrissy and Natalie; great nephews-Patrick and Matthew; many cousins, cherished friends and colleagues.
