“ *My Brother. Even after almost two weeks, the disbelief remains. My mind keeps playing tricks, making me think I can somehow fix this, until the inevitable realization that I can't.*

I just saw you a few weeks ago for Thanksgiving. You were the same Anthony. You were happy, full of energy, ... and late to the party. But as always we were so happy to see you and being late didn't matter to us.

You were the person that would be late to their own funeral. Could you please be late to this funeral?

No matter what the event was, everyone could not wait for you to arrive. How many times did we say, "Where's Anthony?", "When is Anthony coming?", "Have you heard from Anthony?", "Call Anthony".

We all knew you would eventually come, but you followed Anthony Time - i.e. when the party was scheduled to start at 3 PM, your arrival could be 3:30 PM, 4:00 PM, who knows PM.

But whenever you did arrive, we were in bliss. You were the life of the party. We don't know what our future family gatherings are going to be like now with you gone.

With us being close to 7 years apart, I think it's fair and natural to say that we didn't have a close childhood. When I was a teenager getting into my own trouble, you were a little boy playing with Matchbox cars. When I was starting my career and starting to get serious about life, you were the teenager.

I'd say it was only when we became "adults" that we started our bonding in earnest. I thought that we would have many years left to continue bonding. I cannot put into words how deeply saddened I am with the fact that our bonding has been cut short - and cut short by a lot.

I have very fond memories of the various trips we had together over the years. We were in Sicily many years ago when we were kids. I was 18 and you were still a little boy. So that trip was a very distant memory for both of us. For years you asked me to go back to see "the motherland". I procrastinated on that. But we finally made that trip last summer. I am so grateful that we made that trip and that I was able to share that experience with you before you left this world.

I will always remember your love for Granita al Limone and how much of it you ate in Sicily. You loved it so much that you bought a baby Meyer lemon tree so that Mom could make granita at home. Now it's a much bigger tree and bearing beautiful lemons. I will take great care of your tree for the rest of my days and think of you whenever I see it.

I will miss you dearly.
