Bogoljub Trikich, of Crown Point, Indiana formerly of Merrillville, Indiana passed away on September 17, 2024, at the age of 68.

Bogoljub was born in Drvar, Bosna to the late Nebojsa and late Dragica Trikich. He and sister Bozana immigrated with their parents to Northwest Indiana in 1968 where he lived his life.
