Carol Kramer (nee Cowgill), age 64, of Indianapolis, IN, passed away on Wednesday, August 17, 2016. Carol was born in Gary, IN on December 13, 1951. She went to Marquette Elementary School and graduated in 1969 from Wm. A. Wirt High School, Gary, Indiana. She received her B.A. and MPA degrees from Indiana University at Bloomington in 1973 and 1978, respectively, and a Bachelor's degree in interior design from Butler University. Carol grew up in the Miller neighborhood of Gary, IN. There she developed a lifetime passion for the water, beaches and the Indiana Dunes. She returned to the area, throughout her entire lifetime taking her son Eric to many beach communities in Indiana and Michigan. Carol worked in Chicago and San Francisco before choosing to live in Indianapolis.

After working for the State Budget Agency, Indiana General Assembly, and several other public sector organizations Carol formed C. Kramer & Company, a small woman-owned management consulting firm. She did grant writing and project management, generating over \$100 million in grants for a variety of organizations in Indiana. She has previously served on the board of the Storytelling Arts of Indiana non-profit organization.
