Charles Robert Bewick DDS, age 90 of Valparaiso Indiana passed away November 11, 2017. Dr Charles Bewick was born November 15, 1926 in a small mining town of Leisenring No.3, Pennsylvania, and raised in Gary Indiana. Dr. Charles Bewick graduated from Emerson High School, Gary Indiana in 1945. Dr. Charles Bewick enlisted in the Air Force and served during WWII. He was stationed at Hickam Air Force Base Oahu Hawaii. Dr. Charles Bewick went to Indiana University Bloomington IN, and then on to Indiana University Dental School in Indianapolis IN, he graduated Dental School in 1953. Dr. Charles Bewick practiced dentistry in Gary Indiana for 51 years. Dr. Charles Bewick served as Police Commissioner of Gary Indiana from 1968-1972. Dr. Charles Bewick was an avid sports fan, he had season tickets for Indiana University Football, and the Chicago Blackhawks. He also enjoyed politics.
