April 30, 1962 - July 30, 2024

On Tuesday, July 30, 2024, our beloved Cheryl Tarpo (Mucher Dore), age 62, of Ogden Dunes received her wings in peace to start a heavenly journey. Having a spirit that would always light a room, her light has been extinguished far too soon.

Cheryl was preceded in death by her parents, Elmer and Millicent Mucher (Fergus). Raised in Northlake, IL, Cheryl graduated from West Leyden High School in 1980 and Columbia College. She worked for several years in public relations, primarily with the Gatorade account and was proud of her work marketing Gatorade to NFL trainers. After obtaining a master's degree in education from Aurora University, she taught elementary school for the Plainfield (IL) School District. Cheryl had a beautiful voice and enjoyed singing with the Triton College choir while taking classes there.

She is survived by her husband, David; daughter, Gabrielle Mills (Rob); stepdaughters: Natalie Tarpo, Rachel Tarpo and Jessica Tarpo; brother, George Mucher (Tamara); beloved niece, Zoe Mucher; nephew, Ian Mucher; devoted mother-in-law, Judy Tarpo; father-in-law, James Tarpo, Jr. (Margaret); Gabrielle's father, Rick Dore (Linda); close cousins, Wendy Rube and Denise Licciardi and a wide network of extended family and friends.

In 2008, fate brought Cheryl and her husband David together. Their

complementary personalities formed the basis of a strong 16-year marriage during which they raised their blended family of girls.

Cheryl was an accomplished woman who lived life to the fullest, traveling all 7 continents with her husband, exploring restaurants in Chicago, frequently hosting parties, sharing weekends with girlfriends, and mentoring the young people in her life. With her outgoing personality, she collected friends throughout her life and enjoyed connecting new friends with longtime friends. During the day she could often be found walking the beach searching for nature's treasures with her dog Riley, while in the evenings she savored lakefront sunsets with her husband and friends.

An excellent and adventurous cook, Cheryl's home was always open for Monday soup nights with friends as a great way to start off the week. Cheryl excelled at creative cookie baking and decorating, and repeatedly won Best Cookie and Best Packaging awards at her friends' annual holiday cookie contest.

An active member of her community, Cheryl was past President and Treasurer of the Ogden Dunes (IN) Women's Club and enjoyed planning fundraising events. She was an avid reader her entire life and participated in the Ogden Dunes Book Club. She very much enjoyed mentoring others, especially young people, and she befriended, encouraged and inspired girls from Willowcreek Middle School through the Girls To Women program. Following her initial cancer diagnosis, she served as a Mentor Angel to numerous fellow cancer fighters through the Imerman Angels organization.

Our dear Cheryl bravely endured a 16-year battle with breast cancer. She fought the battle tenaciously and with a strong heart. The family wishes to express their sincere thanks to Premier Oncology & Hematology in Merrillville (IN) along with Dr. Bharat Barai and his staff for their exceptional efforts over

the years to treat Cheryl's illness.

“ I've been wanting to write something after hearing the terrible news of Cheryl's passing, but I just didn't know what to say, and I still don't. Words are just hard to come up with. I knew Cheryl had breast cancer years ago, but I didn't know she was still battling it. So the news of her passing caught me completely off guard. I met Cheryl in 1981, the summer we were both counselors at the Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Center in Oregon, Illinois. We had a sweet, innocent, teenage summer romance, and then the summer was over. We never fought or broke up. We just each went on with our lives, and returned to college. Over the next few years we'd see each other at camp reunions, or the odd visit when I was passing through town - just to re-connect and catch up on the other's life. When we re-connected years later, via Facebook, we'd each been married, and divorced, and she remarried a few years before I did. We'd send each other birthday greetings, and try to stay abreast of the big events in each other's lives via our posts and photos. I haven't seen Cheryl for years. But I was very much looking forward to seeing her at another upcoming camp reunion that I was hoping she'd be at. And now that opportunity is gone. I'm so sad that I will never again get to see her huge smile, or hear her contagious laugh, or just bask in her playful presence. As everyone else who has posted anything here knows, and as anyone who ever met Cheryl knows, she was one-of-a-kind. She touched so many lives, and brought smiles to so many people. Reading more on Facebook about her life, and her friends and adventures, since her passing, I realize that I missed most of Cheryl's life. I knew her for one brief summer 43 years ago. I'm not at all surprised by who she turned out to be, and what she accomplished, and all the friends she made along the way. But I'm sad that I didn't continue the effort to stay closer to her, and to more actively nurture our friendship over the years. Those of you who managed to do that - well, you have your reward: your life was touched by that special angel, Cheryl. May we all carry her loving spirit, her laughter, and her playfulness with us for the rest of our lives, and share those gifts with all who we meet - as Cheryl would have done.
