Daniel W. Barrick, Jr., age 85, of Merrillville, IN passed away on Monday, December 5, 2011. Dan was a very proud graduate and athlete of Emerson High School, Class of 1945 and attended the Baltimore Maryland Business College. He was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, WW II serving in the 5th Reconnaissance Squadron. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of Roosevelt Lodge #716 F &A.M. Dan was one of the prominent pioneers in Northwest Indiana Real Estate for over 58 years, until his death. He was the proud owner of Barrick Realty for many years and then partnered with his son David in Red Carpet Barrick Realty, Coldwell Banker Barrick Group and a partner in Coldwell Banker 1st American. Dan was a Real Estate Commissioner for the State of Indiana for 15 years. He was recognized for many, many accomplishments and for being a pillar in the real estate industry. He received the coveted "Realtor of the Year" award from 3 different Boards of Realtors. Governor Robert Orr awarded Dan the Distinguished "Sagamore of the Wabash". Dan was a former member of Innsbrook Country, Better Business Bureau, Exchange Club, Gary and Merrillville Chamber of Commerce. He loved his family, his friends, his God, his life in the real estate business, his flag and his country. He was preceded in death by his wife Dorothy in 2005 and son Daniel "Danny" W. Barrick, III (1977) and parents, Daniel, Sr. and Mary.
