A. Douglas James “Coach”, age 71 of Hobart, passed away April 12, 2015. Doug was a graduate of Hobart High School, class of 1961. He received his Bachelor’s degree in education from Indiana State in 1965 and his Master’s in education from Purdue in 1984. He taught in the Hobart School System for 34 years. After leaving Hobart Doug was the Athletic Director at Hanover Central for 3 years. He was also a former employee of ISM. Doug’s passion was sports and his children. He was instrumental in creating and playing in the Hobart Softball Leagues. He also spent many years officiating sports at various competitive levels. He was an official for the IHSAA and NCAA and a member of the National Education Association. Doug was a very talented organ and piano player and he gave lessons at the Harmony House in Hobart.
