Peacefully at home, Ernest "Bob" Robert Bennett II passed away on January 7th, 2026, at the age of 76. Born on October 16th, 1949, in Gary, Indiana, he was the firstborn child to Ernest and Helen Bennett. Bob received a diploma from Roosevelt High School in Gary, Indiana and later graduated from Ball State University. While at Ball State, he chartered the Theta Xi chapter of the Alpha Phi Alpha fraternity with his brother Michael.

After graduating, he joined the Marines. He was also a member of the Isaak Walton League of America and the National Rifle Association. Bob worked at the Lake County Juvenile Justice Complex for 37 years, with many of those years, serving in the role of Director of the Lake County Juvenile Center. In 2014 he retired and moved to Merrillville, Indiana. He loved watching movies (especially *The Godfather*), carpentry and home repair, collecting firearms, and being a grandfather.
