Ethel Marie Beck passed away peacefully on July 20, 2023, just four days shy of her 95th birthday. She was born July 24th, 1928, to Boyd Willhoite and Mamie (King) Willhoite in Gary, Indiana. Ethel was the oldest child and lost her mother when she was only 6 years old.
