Glenn Allen Sterba, age 83, of Gary, passed away at home June 20, 2009.

Glenn was a lifetime resident of "Old Ross" in Calumet Township. He was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Emily Sterba. Glenn attended Ross School and graduated from Gary Horace Mann in 1943. In WWII, he attended Ohio Wesleyan in the Navy College Program.
