Earl Brock, age 90 of Crown Point, IN, formerly of Freetown, IN passed away June 30, 2014. He was born July 4th, 1923 in Freetown, IN to Fred and Aileen "Harbaugh" Brock. Earl was a retired school teacher. He was a 1941 Graduate of Freetown High School. He served in the 20th Air Force of the US Army Air Corps during WWII. He was a Combat veteran of the Central Pacific Theatre awarded the Purple Heart and Air Medal. He received a Bachelor's Degree in Education from Indiana University and a Master's in Education from Butler University. He taught school in Indianapolis for 37 years, teaching at Bluff Avenue School, IPS School No. 65, and Wanamaker and Acton Elementary Schools. Earl was a member of the Brownstown/Seymour VFW. He was raised a master mason at Clearspring Lodge in Kurtz, IN and 50+ year member of Washington Lodge #13, Brownstown, IN. He was an avid bird hunter and owned English Setters most of his life. He was a Baptized member of Freetown Christian Church and also Southport Heights Christian Church in Indianapolis. He was preceded in death by his sister - Hazel Brock Bland.
