Janet McDermott (nee Quade), age 80 of Merrillville, IN, passed away on January 16, 2026. She was a member of the first graduating class of Andean High School 1963, “An Original 59er”. She was preceded in death by her husband of 52 years Robert J. McDermott; her parents, Jack A. and Marie M. Quade; and her brother, Jack A. Leading to a whirlwind week of booking flights, hotel, rental car; purchasing 4th row concert tickets and scheduling a day long “side trip” to Puget Sound. Lastly, Janet was unique in that she was born 01-23-1945, married 01-23-1965, and we will now gather on 01-23-2026 to celebrate her life.
