



## Joseph Neverauskas

May 1, 1918 - August 4, 2016

Joseph Neverauskas, age 98 of Munster, IN passed away on Thursday, August 4, 2016. He was born on May 1, 1918 in the region of Sakiu, Paluobiai, Lithuania to Jonas and Natalia (Usas) Neverauskas. Joe was the oldest and last of 10 siblings. He established his headstrong work ethic at an early age, tending the family farm. Joe matured into a strong young man just as the world plunged into war for a second time and bravely defended his family and country. After incredible countless hardships, Joseph met his beautiful wife of 68 years, Josephine (Frey), on a fortunate occurrence in her war-torn hometown of Eichstätt, Germany. In 1950, the couple moved with renewed hope to NWI, where their hard work and perseverance paved way to the American dream.

Joe will forever be remembered for the countless homes he built throughout the region, under Joe's Construction. He was a parishioner and usher at St. Thomas More in Munster, and was heavily involved in the region's Lithuanian community. Joe was well-known as a fishing fanatic among all, and developed a fondness for gardening later in life. His boundless energy was additionally spent at Fitness Pointe, where he could be found socializing at the pool or rowing thousands of km in their annual competition. Above all, Joe was devoted to his family and gave of himself unconditionally. He is survived by his loving and dedicated wife, Josephine, son, Joe Jr., granddaughters Audrey and Ella; daughter, Maryanne Neverauskas-Topor, son-in-law, Mark Topor, and grandsons Christopher and Joseph.
