Kire Pavlovski, age 84 of Crown Point, returned to his heavenly home on March 23, 2020 after a valiant battle with a long illness. Kire was born on April 18, 1935 in the small village of Bolno located in the mountains of Macedonia. As a young man, Kire proudly served in the Yugoslav People's Army alongside the men of his generation for the defense of their homelands. After his military service, he departed his beloved Macedonia to cross the ocean in search of a new future.

Kire would come to the United States and eventually find work in the steel mills of Northwest Indiana. There he spent the rest of his life with his wife, Vaskresija, who cared for him until his last days.

During his retirement, Kire spent his time exercising at his local health club, playing tennis and chess, and helping to raise his grandchildren.

Unfortunately, Kire's final years were very difficult for him as he struggled with Parkinson's Disease. However, his loving family was there to provide him with all the care and assistance he needed during his long fight with the illness.

Kire is survived by his wife, Vaskresija Pavlovska; his brother, Vlado (Dobri) Pavlovski; his son, Sasko (Nada) Pavlovski; his stepson, Ljupco (Theresa) Andonovski; his grandsons, Kire and Boris Pavlovski; and his granddaughter, Valerie Andonovski. He is preceded in death by his parents, Ilija and Vesa Pavlovski; and his sister, Vera Ristevska.
