Lewis (Ljupco) Dimovski, age 63 of St. John, Indiana passed away May 21, 2023. He was born in Bitola, Macedonia on January 16, 1960 to his parents, Dimitrija and Vera. Lewis immigrated to the United States with his mother in January 1967 during one of Chicago's biggest blizzards, joining his father who was already in East Chicago, Indiana.
