Luanne Ana Vuyakovich, age 64, recently of Valparaiso, Indiana, fell asleep in the Lord on Thursday, January 22, 2026. She was born January 31, 1961, in Gary, Indiana, to the late Gilbert and Nancy Vuyakovich.

She possessed a rare gift for lifting others up with grace and eloquence.

Luanne's warm personality and genuine concern for others were known to everyone who knew her. She had a tender heart for the less fortunate, and in recent years, even out of her meager means, she provided food and shelter to a homeless individual by denying herself. Her quiet acts of compassion reflected the depth of her faith and the sincerity of her love. It is no surprise that the good Lord was the center of her being. She cared for and prayed for others, often thanking God for His blessings upon them.

Luanne is preceded in death by her parents, Gilbert and Nancy Vuyakovich, and her cherished brother, Dale.
