Lucy loved travelling and had only a few states left to see. She traveled to Canada, Jerusalem the Holy Land, Italy, Vatican City, Mexico, St. Thomas, and traveled countless times to her beloved Puerto Rico. She was a great cook and loved cooking, gardening, having flowers and plants around her, loved music and dancing, she loved pretty shoes and stylish dressing. Lucy was a woman of great faith and a great prayer warrior. She loved praying the rosary and did countless rosary novenas for many people. Lucy was a Eucharistic Minister and Lector in several churches in the Catholic Diocese of Gary, a member of the Hispanic Ministry of the Diocese of Gary, Legion of Mary for over fifty plus years, was involved in the Cursillo for many years. She had a Perpetual membership in the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary from the National Shrine of Our Lady of Champion. Lucy was a member of the Hermanas Unidas and the National Conference of Puerto Rican Women. She was a homemaker but did work for about a year at the Zachary Confections in Chicago, IL. Lucy was involved in helping out at the polls during voting and worked in many campaigns. She had a beautiful soul, was a very kind, generous, loving person, and supported many charities. Lucy loved her family and enjoyed spending time with them, they meant everything to her. She was a devoted wife to her husband Carlos and they were married for 70 years, this

June would have been 71 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents Zenon Lopez and Paula Guzman and all her siblings.
