



Maenon Doreen Belec

November 28, 1930 - January 22, 2024

Maenon Doreen (Someson) Belec, age 93, passed away the morning of January 22, 2024 at her home in Hobart, IN, surrounded by her loved ones. Born on November 28, 1930, to Victor Someson and Angeline (née Zavada) Someson in Tolleston, IN, Maenon lived a full and rich life. She was a graduate of Tolleston High School, where she was President of the Girl's Athletic Association (G.A.A) and played the trumpet in the band. She married her soulmate Donald P. Belec on June 25, 1949. He preceded her in death in 1992. We take comfort in the knowledge that they are now reunited.

In her 93 years, Maenon traveled to over a dozen countries and curated a collection of treasures from her many adventures. Whether viewed from the deck of a cruise ship or from the back of a horse, the world continually opened its arms to Maenon and never ceased to amaze her. She held fast to special memories of exploring her ancestral homeland in Prague, as well as visiting the destruction of the Berlin Wall with her husband Don. While the memories sustained, Maenon's thirst for adventure never waned: she parasailed in Maui at age 80, went snorkeling in the Pacific, and whitewater rafted in Alaska at age 83.

Maenon devoted much of her life to raising her two hardworking children, a dedication which involved welcoming many exotic pets into their home. An animal lover who became a favorite among everyone who had the pleasure of knowing her, she was always armed with a big smile, a word of encouragement, and a pocket full of treats for pups. As a wife, parent, and

grandmother she showed continuous support to her loved ones, attending their many celebratory events (local elections, graduations, performances, cookouts, weddings, and more). Maenon was cherished by many for her wisdom, optimism, and boundless wit, all of which she demonstrated until she departed this life. The title she cherished the very most was that of Great-Grandmother to Tucker Belec (age 4) and Freyja Belec (age 5 months) for whom she shared immense love.

Maenon was preceded in death by her parents, her stepfather, Ted Yuriga; her brothers-in-law, Bill Hall and Anthony Yudt; and her son-in-law, Wayne Radant. She is survived by her son, Donald "Doug" (Marla) Belec; her daughter, Kimberly Radant (Michael) Husek; her sisters, Diane Hall and Denise Evans; her grandchildren, Kyle (Allena) Belec, Kayla (Stefan) Roseen, Jess (Andy) Ferguson, and Jeremiah Husek; her sister-in-law, Donna Yudt; her nephews Jeff (Nora) Hall, Michael C. (Alice) Evans, Bob Yudt, and Rick Yudt; and her nieces Toni Perconti and Terri (Allen) Cullen, as well as cousins and great nieces. She will be profoundly missed.

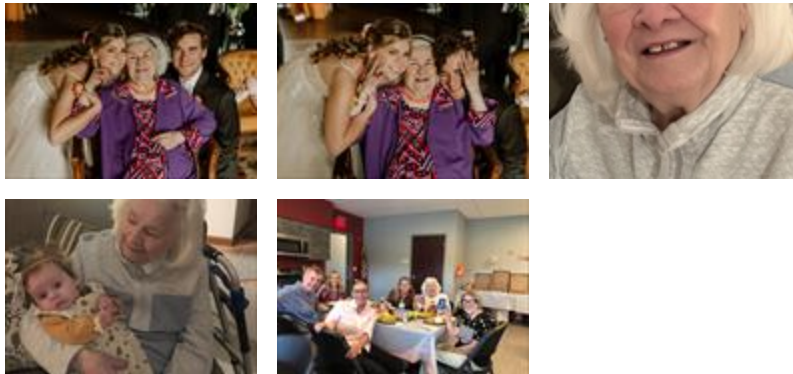
