Marjorie "Marge" Everett Boyden, age 92, of Portage, formerly of Hobart, passed away October 3, 2018. She was born May 5, 1926, the first child of William and Estelle Everett of Vincennes, IN. Marge was married to Robert E. Boyden of Gary, IN., on June 26, 1949. She was a graduate of Fritchton High School, Vincennes University and Purdue University with a BS degree in Home and General Science. Marge taught Home Science classes at Washington, East Chicago, Wirt, and Edison in Gary, as well as 5th grade in Lorton, VA.

Bob and Marge constructed their own home in Miller, where they lived for 43 years. They were both active Scout leaders with their three sons. Marge was a room mother for all three of her sons. They traveled through most of the states in a travel trailer with their sons during summer vacations. She loved the Dunes, entertaining, needle work, reading and gardening, which she found relaxing. Humming birds would come within six inches of her when she was on her knees pulling weeds.
