



Mark Anthony Torres

June 5, 1979 - March 25, 2024

Mark Anthony Torres, age 44, of Hobart, died on March 25, 2024, from a massive coronary attack. Mark was born on June 5, 1979, he is survived by his daughter, Colette Torres and her mother, Toni Torres; his mother, Teresa Torres; sister Rachel (David) Bell; nieces Madeline and Fiona Bell and several cousins. He was preceded in death by his father, Hector Torres and grandparents, Bill and Virginia Curtis.

Mark had the soul of a true artist, and a unique sense of humor. His smile would literally light up the room, especially when he was talking about his daughter, Coco, who was the light of his life from the day she was born. After graduating from Merrillville High School in 1998, he attended the American Academy of Art and Columbia College in Chicago. As DJ Mark One Torres, he developed a large following of house music fans, playing all over Chicago and headlining at venues across the country. Proud to have been mentored by the late Paul Johnson, he produced music about peace and love, and still treasured the many friends he made from that scene. Mark relished everything from Irish singers to old time Motown and was so happy that his daughter inherited his love of music.

He was the reason for the creation of the non-profit disability rights agency Everybody Counts in 1986. Later, as a counselor/advocate he truly connected with all kinds of people and made a real difference in their lives, before becoming Systems Manager and bringing everybody there into the 21st century through his love of computers.

Mark was also a youth camp counselor for the American Coalition of Amputees, where he mentored young people, many of whom still kept in touch. As an active member of ADAPT, a national grass roots coalition, he participated in numerous rallies and compiled several documentaries. A non-denominational memorial featuring his photos and music will be held Saturday, April 6, 2024, at Burns Funeral Home, 701 E. 7th Street in Hobart, from 1 to 5 p.m. Refreshments will be provided throughout, and friends are encouraged to bring memories and stories to share at 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. www.BurnsFuneral.com

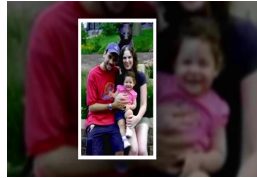

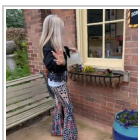
