“ I am so sorry to hear about Marty's passing. Please extend my condolences to the entire family. My 3 year stint working with Marty just after he opened the bike shop were some of the most fun times in my life. I stopped into the shop to buy a battery for my Ducati, and inquired about getting a part time job. I had just been discharged from the Air Force and was starting college at Prairie State. He asked me if I could fix the Honda 750 in the shop that had a broken crankcase from a chain failure. I said no, but the same thing happened to mine and I had a shop in Crete weld the crack for \$50. He was impressed with my creative solution, and hired me on the spot, even though I didn't really know much at all.

I still remember so many of the crazy antics we all did. Marty doing wheelies on his Triumph Trident in front of the shop. TorqueFlight coming to the shop every Friday night. John Jacobsen coming in regularly. The bike rides that always ended up in Sauk Village where we drank coffee and ate and talked for a few hours. (That's where I learned to drink coffee!) Our trip around Lake Michigan when I hit a deer on my Moto Guzzi. I rode back seat with Marty for another 8 hours back to IL.

I drove the Blue MG Midget that I bought from him (one of the girls owned it) for almost 20 years! One night Marty and Torque got into it at the same time, and they couldn't get the doors to close. We laughed our butts off! Those were fun years, and I was fortunate to be part of the shop and the family.
