Mary "Kay" Thacker Woodall passed away on October 21, 2025, at home, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Talking Rock, Georgia, 92 years ago. When she was five, her family moved to Maryville, Tennessee. She graduated from Everett High School, where she met her husband, Dallas.

Kay's life was built on faith in God and love for her family. She and Dallas began their family in Rockford, Tennessee, before moving to Indiana in search of a better life. There, they joined the First Baptist Church of East Gary, where Kay was a devoted and humble servant-always working quietly behind the scenes, never seeking recognition or praise.
