



Mattison "Matt" A. Dilts

July 8, 1951 - June 24, 2025

Mattison Andrew Dilts, aged 73, lifelong resident of the Miller Beach section of Gary, Indiana, died on June 24, 2025, from complications related to lung and heart disease. A graduate of Wirt High School's class of 1969 and Indiana University Bloomington, where he obtained his BA and MS degrees, Matt gave generously to his community throughout his life, beginning as a director of the Alternative House, an emergency shelter for teens that is part of the Crisis Center, where Matt was later a board member. Following in his father Mose Dilts' footsteps, Matt served as a financial advisor helping families, executives and businesses across Chicagoland build and maintain wealth. A longtime member of the National Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors (NAIFA) and twice past president of the Northwest Indiana chapter, Matt sat on the board of Methodist Hospital where he championed improvements for the hospital's North campus in Gary, as well as Indiana University N.W., where he worked to develop opportunities for its business school students. He also sat on the boards of Lake Area United Way, Northwest Indiana Food Bank (a charter board member) and The ARC of NW Indiana, an organization which his son, Benjamin Dilts, later contributed to. He was preceded in death by his son Ben, and his parents, Mose and Pat Dilts. Matt is survived by his beloved wife, Geneie W. Dilts; daughter, Elizabeth Dilts Marshall; son in law, Wyatt Marshall, and grandchildren, Winona and Loewy Marshall. A visitation will be held at Burns Funeral Home & Crematory, 10101 Broadway, Crown Point, IN, on Monday, June 30, 2025,

from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Funeral services will take place at Marquette Park United Methodist Church, 215 North Grand Blvd., Gary, IN, on Tuesday, July 1, 2025, from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m., with Pastor Leah Peksenak officiating. 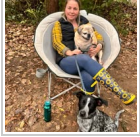

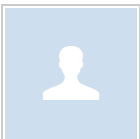
