Nancy Louise (Brady) Mulloy was born in Gary, Indiana (Glen Park) on October 10, 1929, the youngest of Allen and Margaret (Powers) Brady's three girls. Nancy died in Crown Point on December 2, 2024. Her parents and sisters (Alice Donley, Patricia McCallister) pre-deceased her.

An Emerson High School graduate, Nancy married fellow Emersonian Gerald F. Mulloy on a rainy October Saturday at St. Luke's Catholic Church on Gary's East Side. Notre Dame's Fighting Irish lost that day, but the Mulloy-Brady match was a win. After a honeymoon in the Smokey Mountains, they returned to Gary where Gerald joined the Fire Department and they became parents to four children, all graduates of Andean High School: Peggy Mulloy (New York); Kathleen (James) Essany (Idaho); Gerald (Barbara) Mulloy (Crown Point); and Michael Mulloy (Merrillville). Survivors also include three grandchildren (Erin Geimer, Amy Snelson, Patrick Essany), five great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. Nancy's heart also held much love for dogs and her canine children included Suzie, Minnie, Boots, another Minnie, Daisy and Penny.

Nancy was an avid reader who used her library card constantly. She believed in the importance of voting and instilled that conviction in all of her children. With her children raised, Nancy worked for several years at the Gary Post Tribune where her distinctively sweet voice contributed to her success in telephone sales.

Nancy and Gerald retired for 15+ years to the Southern Indiana town of

Jasper before returning to the Region in 2017. They lived in Winfield until 2020. After Gerald's passing that year, Nancy moved to Christian Village where she received kind and considerate accommodation until her passing.
