Neil G. Kohler, age 89, of Hobart passed away on Saturday, May 16, 2020. He was born on August 8, 1930 in Chicago, IL. Neil was a graduate of Chesterton High School, Class of 1948. He retired from US Steel Gary Works after 30 years and later worked at Burns Funeral Home. Neil also retired as a Warrant Officer in the US Army Reserves after 20 years where he was a part of the Airborne Unit. He was a member of the Illiana Power Squadron and the Knights of Columbus, where he received the title of "Grand Knight". Neil was a dedicated member of St. Bridget Catholic Church in Hobart.
