She was born on October 3, 1950, in Chicago IL. Paulette went to St. Bronislava Grammer School, and Bowen High School. She worked at South Chicago hospital as a nurse's aid for 3 years. In 1972 she married the love of her life-James P. Paul. Paulette enjoyed cooking, decorating, and needlepoint. With her mother's support and recipes, she became a great cook, and her decorating skills were fantastic throughout her life. She was a friend to everyone she met and was always concerned and would support people in need. Paulette would also continually support St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. In 1972 she graduated from Thornton Community College as a nurse. She worked for a couple of doctors and a medical center, and then settled at the VA Medical Clinic in Crown Point. Paulette retired from the VA in 2013. At the VA she always took in the most difficult and upset Veterans and was able to calm them down and assist in all their medical needs. With her support her medical team of one doctor and two nurses won a prestigious award for veteran support and detailed documentation of veteran problems, from the award from the VA Headquarters. In retirement, over time, health problems started and slowed her down, but she continued her needlepoint and support for all of her friends. She always loved, and enjoyed being with her granddaughter, Sydney. Paulette was preceded in death by her parents-Dorothy and Victor Remely; brother- George Remely; daughters- Tracy Paul

and Brandy Paul. She is survived by her husband of 52 years- James P. Paul, son- James D. Paul; granddaughter- Sydney Paul; grandson- Christian Paul; brother- David Remely, and sister- Patricia Tunney.
