Dr. Pravinkumar Chhabildas Sanghvi, age 84, of Merrillville, Indiana, passed away on April 5, 2026, peacefully at home.

He was born on April 10, 1941, to Ruxmani and Dr Chhabildas Sanghvi in Karachi, Pakistan before spending most of his childhood in Mumbai. He was a graduate of Indore Medical College.

Dr. Sanghvi was a skilled obstetrician/gynecologist and surgeon who delivered thousands of babies over the course of his career, a strong supporter of his extended family, and a loving father, husband and grandfather.
