Robert “Bob” Malizzo, age 75, of Hobart, passed away March 14, 2019. Bob was a graduate of Gary Edison High School, Class of 1963. He served in the U.S. Army. Bob was a former employee of the City of Gary. He served on the Lake County Sheriff’s Department from 1967-1980. Bob formerly owned a cable installation service and a security business. He served as Mayor of Hobart from 1992-1996. Bob was the owner and CEO of Med Staff Inc., in Hobart. He and his wife, Barbara, were patient advocates for C.M.S. and other hospital organizations.

Bob was preceded in death by his daughter-Michelle; brother-George; parents-George and Libby Malizzo. He is survived by his wife of 52 years-Barbara (nee Benner); daughter Kristina Chavez of Hobart; grandchildren-Brianna and Olivia Ballog, Adrian and Mia Chavez; several loving nieces, nephews and cousins.
