



Robert E. Swartz

August 22, 1941 - January 23, 2026

Robert E. Swartz, a Merrillville-based CPA, who joined his father's firm, Swartz, Retson & Co., as an accounting apprentice, and stayed for more than five decades mostly as a managing partner, before reluctantly retiring from his legacy, died peacefully at his home on January 23, 2026. He was 84. He was born on August 22, 1941, in Gary, Indiana, to Eugene Swartz, who was the city's mayor during his son's childhood, and Sophia Swartz, a volunteer at the Saint Mary's Hospital Auxiliary. Mr. Swartz graduated from William A. Wirt High School and the Indiana University School of Business, where he was a fraternity brother at Alpha Tau Omega. He also attended the Graduate School of Business Administration at Northwestern University. He once was president of the Visiting Nurse Association, University Club and the Andean Foundation. And the Indiana CPA Society counted him as a 50-year member, serving on the Board of Directors and Leadership Cabinet. When taking a break from numbers, some of his fondest memories were flying his Cherokee Archer plane, watching auto racing, strolling the shore of Miller Beach and shopping with his wife and girls.

His older sister, Judie (Roger) Shurr, died in 2018. He is survived by his younger sister, Mari Jo (Daniel) Stewart. His wife, Bonnie Swartz, to whom he was wed for 58 years, also survives, along with their three daughters, Julie, Brenda and Allison Swartz; son-in-law, Eric Mango; and his dear granddaughter, Magdalen Swartz-Mango.
