In 1996 Roger founded RLG.com, a global supplier of ink cartridges (Headquarters

warehouse in Gary, Indiana until 2015). Roger considered himself an internet pioneer and operated this highly successful business up until his passing. Despite his aptitude for business, Roger would happily tell anyone who asked about his true pride and biggest accomplishment, his daughter, Gail Irene Goodan.

Roger loved spending hours playing his favorite game "China Shores" and was a participant in the 2012 World Series of Poker.

Roger's laugh filled up every room he entered, and his genuine smile was one that you couldn't help but mirror. He will be greatly missed.

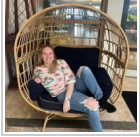
