Ronald J. Makatura, age 53, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Friday, May 13, 2022, in his home after a long, painful illness. He wanted to leave I.U. Medical Center after weeks of care but wanted to be home and was prepared to go to his “final home”. Ronald was born on August 20, 1968, to Ronald J. Makatura, Sr. and Marvalynn Makatura in Gary, Indiana. He graduated from Portage High School. Ronald is survived by his wife, Marie; children: Jacqueline Marie, Andrew Joseph, Brianna Lynn; mother, Marvalynn Makatura-Sheets (nee Harpp), stepfather, Dennis E. Sheets, his loving brother and best friend, Tommy and his wife, Lori, niece- Olivia, and nephew- Joseph. Ronald’s grandparents the Harpp’s (deceased) were very special to him as was his Aunt Geri and Uncle Bill whom are deceased. He is leaving aunts, uncles and numerous cousins, especially Lori and Tom Liesenfelt who helped me through this rough time. He got his first job as an employee at his Dad and Mom’s place of employment, Wise Way Foods at 16 years old. He then worked at Opportunity Enterprises with his younger brother Tommy working with the disabled. Ronald and all of his family loved music our whole lives. He taught himself with the help of a friend how to play the guitar and drums. He was a diehard Beatles fan and went to Paul McCartney and Ringo Star concerts. He was a true music lover and raised his children to appreciate music too. Ronald was a disc jockey (DJ) from the time

he was 16 years old. He learned the job from close friends who were DJ's and played any occasion from kids parties to the US Steel mills, Opportunity Enterprises for the clients, weddings and anytime anyone wanted music for an occasion. Up until his father's passing in 2000, he was his assistant and worked together helping sort music and just wanted to be with his son. Ronald was a proud Teamster of Local Union No. 142. He worked for Kuraray Company for 20 years until his illness forced him to retire early. He trained to be a scuba diver in Lake County Diving School in Hobart IN. Ronald proudly served his country in the United States Army Reserves, he believed in the Constitution and was a true American. Ronald was very active in the veterans association. He followed the news and was a great history reader. Ronald was a member of Nativity of Our Savior Catholic Church in Portage, IN and believed in the power of the Lord. He joyfully told me he was ready to meet him. Ronald and Tommy's father whom they loved and were dearly devoted to passed away in 2000. It was a loss that a child never recovers from as well as a spouse. Ronald has more friends than we could count. Never an enemy.
