Scott William Campbell, age 65, of Crown Point, IN, sadly passed away on March 14, 2024. Scott grew up in Hartland, WI, off of North Lake, and spent his days swimming and enjoying the water with his parents, siblings, and cousins. He was a graduate of Arrowhead High School, class of 1976, located in Hartland, WI, where he played high school football.
