Scott Kaech, a cherished son, beloved brother, loving husband, devoted father, caring uncle, and friend to many, passed away on Wednesday, January 21, 2026, at the age of 39. Born on August 27, 1986, Scott's life—though far too short—was defined by love, family, hard work, and living life without fear.
