Scott W. Millsap, age 42, of Crown Point, passed away on Thursday, September 19, 2024, in Hobart, Indiana. He was born on June 26, 1982, in Blue Island, Illinois to Floyd and Pamela (Richter) Millsap.

Scott had many treasured friends. At a young age he was a loyal boy scout, reaching the rank of Eagle Scout in 2000. While a Senior in High School, he stopped at the United States Marines Recruiting Center in Crown Point, following in his father's footsteps, he enlisted.

After graduating high school in 2000, he went to Boot Camp in San Diego. He was attached to the 2/24 Marine Reserve Unit out of Chicago, serving two tours in Iraq, and a humanitarian mission in Niger, Africa. During his second Iraq tour, he earned the rank of Sargent.

After 10 years, he was honorably discharged and hired in at the I. H. B. Railroad, where both of his parents, grandfather, and uncle were employed. Railroading was in his blood! After a couple of years, Scott went to locomotive training school in Atlanta, Georgia to become a locomotive engineer, a job he truly loved.

Scott loved camping, Disney World, and Florida. The Bon- Aire Motel in St. Pete Beach, FL was his happy place.

Scott was preceded in death by his father, Floyd Millsap; brother, Edward; sister, Debbie, and an uncle, Warren Coleman. His faithful and loving companion, Cocoa joined him in Heaven the day after Scott passed.

He leaves behind his mother, Pamela; brothers- Joseph, David, and Daniel;

sisters- Pamela, Glenda, and Tracy. Also surviving are his cherished cousin- Becki Calomino; dear aunt, Cheryl Steffens and uncle, Harry Richter. The family wishes to extend a special thank you to Dave Cox for being there for Scott on his final day.

“ Scott Millsap was a part of Echo 3rd Platoon, the Battalion Bastards, during the historical and bloody effort in Al Anbar Province OIF 2-2, a member of Fox 4 platoon who lead teams and squads in Africa and across many training fields, Watch Chief in operations during his return to Iraq OIF 8-2, and on his last tour out of the CONUS a guide and occasionally first squad leader of 1st Platoon of an infantry company that distinguished itself by way of debarking and training with marines, soldiers, and naval members of groups from Singapore, Okinawa Japan, Brunei, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, and the Philippines. He studied knife fighting, hand to hand combat, and survival with experts across the continent. He not only earned a combat action ribbon but became a shellback for completing the Green side indoctrination event and crossing the equator while in a support of Operation Enduring Freedom on the USS Harper’s Ferry then of the John S. McCain Battle Group. While in Asia he completed and became qualified as a Jungle Warfare Specialist after completing a grueling NCO course in the jungles of Okinawa. Scott Millsap ate, breathed, and bleed the Marine Corps. I knew him as such and deployed with no man more than him. Near the end of his time in the Marine Corps together he and I could communicate with our eyes from the distance of bivouac or on the live fire hills of southeast Asia. He was honest. With me, his friend’s, the marines he led, and himself. He was kind and held no ill will when there was missions to be done. He had answers and did studies to provide knowledge because it was in him to be part of and knowledgeable of our wonderful corps. He never turned down the hard jobs. He made those around him better for showing them how to endure, move forward, and control struggle and frustration with grace and jokes. He made me smile. He made me laugh in places where laughter was not common. He made the heat of the jungle seem like a summer day at great America. He was a familiar face to welcome one into a brotherhood I can not fully explain. In short, he was a silver lining in a olive drab world. I will miss him. I am better for having a Scott Milsap in my memories and having shared time with him. Semper Fidelis Milhouse. And thank you for your service.
