Humility:

He was so very bright, yet admitted that he didn't know everything.

Equitability:

No matter your level of education, he treated you as an equal and valued your input.

Kindness:

I truly never heard him speak ill of anyone.

Compassion:

There was a health scare involving my mother many years ago and his involvement made all the difference, both medically and emotionally.

Patience:

No matter how tired he may have been (and there were plenty of times when that was the case), he neither lost his temper nor seemed annoyed in any way. He always took time for you and no question was without merit. He made you feel significant.

There is so much more I could say, but I'm sure you know all this already. My life in and outside of health care has been enriched by having spent some of that time with Dr. Mothkur. We worked together for only a few years, but he always remembered me and asked after my family whenever we happened to meet. He possessed a loving heart.

While my feelings have no comparison to your grief, his death affects me deeply...as did his life.

I am distressed that my present work prevents me from being physically present at his tribute, but I shall be there in my own way. It must be quite difficult at times for physician's families to cope with the demands of their work, so I thank you deeply and sincerely for sharing him with us. I WILL miss him.
