Terrence Lee Bush (TB2), of Crown Point, Indiana, passed away on June 15, 2024, at age 67. Terrence was born to parents, Lee and Judy Bush. He was raised in Morrison, IL and graduated from high school in Eureka, IL. Terry ventured on to be a professional window washer, landscaper and retired Local 150 Operating Engineer.
