That was my last 2-way conversation with my father before he passed, the last time I heard his voice. It was my Uncle Thomas who then linked me to my Aunt Carmen 3 days later, on my birthday, so she could relay to me that I need to get home from Iraq ASAP if there is any chance for me to see and speak (1-way at this point) to my father again before he goes. I'm grateful to my Uncle Thomas for this connection.

For some reason, I've always remembered the day my dad told me that he named me, Steven Thomas Rivera, after his little brother. I am beyond proud and honored to bear the namesake of a man with the character, presence and intellect of my Uncle Thomas. Every time I thanked him, either in person or over the phone for his unending support to my father in his final months/weeks/days, Uncle Thomas would shrug it off and say, "he's my brother." Regardless, Uncle Thomas, Lana and I both say "Thank you" one last time. You are eternally loved and appreciated.
