THOMAS "Tom" P. KEILMAN, age 66, of Crown Point, Indiana, passed away peacefully on June 28, 2025, at Methodist Hospital surrounded by his loving family. Tom was born in East Chicago, IN and spent his early life in Hessville, IN. After receiving degrees from both the University of South Dakota and Indiana University, Tom planted roots in Northwest Indiana. He became the first Town Manager of Merrillville and continued on to spend 20 years as Director of Government Public Affairs at BP. He is survived by his devoted wife of 35 years, Kimberly; loving daughters: Anna (Andrew) and Helen; loyal dog: Baxter; two brothers, Jack and Robert (Kimberly) and one sister, Kathleen (Brian) as well as his nieces and nephews who he cherished deeply.
