Timothy F. Garver, age 70 of Valparaiso, passed away after a long battle with cancer and diabetes, August 21, 2015. He graduated from Horace Mann High School in 1962 and Parsons College in 1970, where he received degrees in business and aviation. 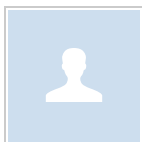
