William Robert "Bob" Krebs, age 70, of Hobart, passed away April 17, 2018. He was born in Gary, IN to William S. Krebs and Sheila Krebs (nee Midson) and was raised in Glen Park. Bob served in the Army from 1965 to 1969, owned and operated A@B Trucking Company in the 1980's and retired from U.S. Steel in 2011.
