William L. Staehle age 78 of Valparaiso, formerly of Miller, passed away on January 2, 2011. He was a graduate of Proviso East High School in Maywood, IL, class of 1949. He was a veteran of the Korean Conflict – U. S. Army. After the service he received his B. S. in Architecture and Master's Degree in Urban Planning from Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago. He was a former City Planner for the city of Gary, Model Cities Director for the city of Gary, and Director for the Indiana/Illinois Bi-State Commission.
